

This is one of the special foods or snacks of Yogyakarta which is popular among tourists. Bakpia is made by mung beans and sugar wrapped with skin made of flour. Tourists can visit the processing of Bakpia located in Patuk area, Ngampilan, ± 1.5 km from Malioboro street.

Batik
Batik is also one of the handicrafts that are often used as souvenirs. Tourists can buy the fabric or clothes. Batik of Yogyakarta has several motifs such: Ceplok/ Grompol, Kawung, Parang, Lereng, Nitik, Truntum, Semen, Garuda, dan Isen.



Perak
Tourists can find silver handicrafts in Kotagede that becomes silver industrial complex. There are many showrooms for silver processing such as jewelry, brooches, home decoration collections, miniatures such as tricycles, bicycles, ships, golden chariots, temples, statues.

Wayang
Wayang Kulit or Leather Puppet is usually used for puppet shows performed by the puppeteer. This handicrafts are also formed as bookmarks, key chains, fans, and miniatures that can be found along Malioboro Street, Beringharjo Market, Hamzah Batik and Hadi Sukirno Souvenir Shop.
